## **Student Policy**

Students in placement will be encouraged to take an active part within the general nursery life and will be supported by the potential. We will achieve this by:

- The student visiting prior to their agreed start date to discuss mutual expectations.
- Starting with where to find the nursery's policies and procedures, and student details form;
- Assigning the student to a supervisor within their base room (the nursery will only offer a
  placement to one student per room, so as not to overwhelm the room and therefore be
  unable to offer effective support and supervision to the student).
- The student attending for the full seven and a half hours of the working day (either 8 to 4.30 or 9 to 5.30, with the usual lunch break; different hours may be agreed if the student is travelling from outside Cambridge and is relying on public transport); unless they are school work experience students.
- Including them in any fundraising events or outside excursions as appropriate during their time.
- The Manager and Supervisor reviewing competences one month after the start date to assess the student's ability (this clause applies to long-term students only). This does not apply to school work experience students.
- Applying our safe guarding policy, this will mean that students are not allowed unsupervised toilet changing duties, and they will not be placed in vulnerable situations for their own protection.
- Giving access to all training materials within the Nursery.

## The following requirements will apply:

- Students must follow instruction on behavior and practice given by supervisors and staff.
- Students are not permitted to offer any outside childcare arrangements to families of children within the Nursery.
- Students will not be permitted to administer medicines and will only be allowed to assist in basic first aid.
- Students will adhere to all nursery policies and procedures, paying special attention to confidentiality and General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR).
- Photography is not permitted unless otherwise agreed with the supervisor.
- Mobile phones, cameras or any technical devices are not allowed in the Nursery.
- Students will always seek nursery and parental permission prior to carrying our observations or any other work in relation to their courses.
- For reasons of safety, jewelry should be kept to a minimum.
- Long hair should be tied back.
- Flat shoes and a college top should be worn.
- If the student is not able to attend the nursery, they should report this by telephone by 8.00am.
- Students are to bring their own lunch.
